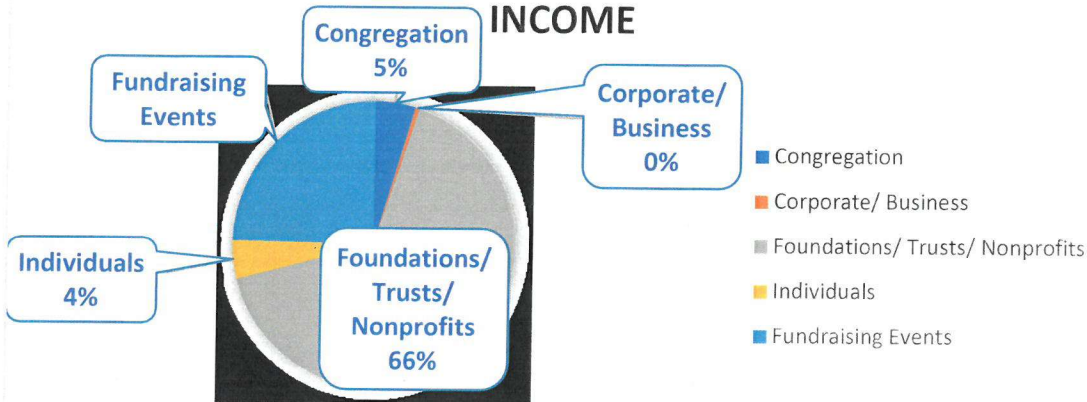
Provided over 1,889 counseling hours to current guests and graduates. Facilitated over 225 parenting group hours.



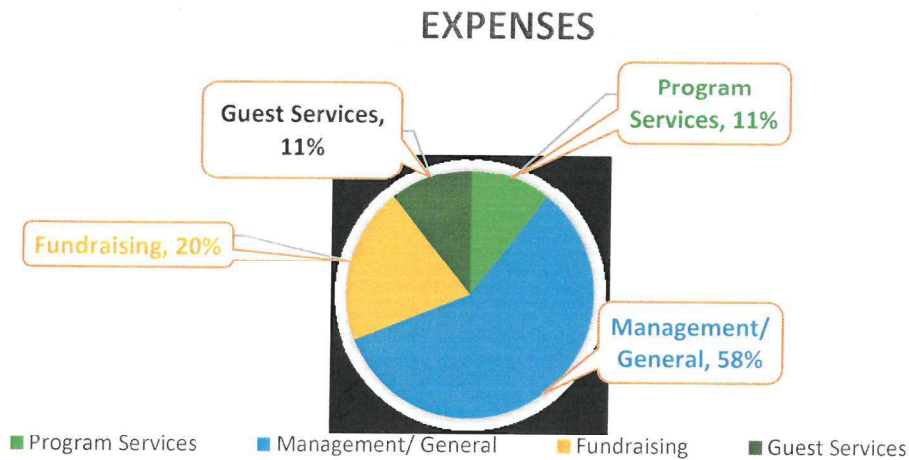
